CCRC is the home of the largest database of child care programs in the region and offers a combination of free and fee-based services to suit the needs of every family. Our free resource and referral services are available to anyone needing assistance finding quality child care. Among the fee-based services are corporate services that provide enhanced child care referral services to employees as part of their benefits package and a nanny referral service.

In 1991, the Junior League of Winston-Salem, Northwest Child Development Council, The Winston-Salem Foundation, the United Way of Forsyth County and local corporations provided research and funding to support the development of Child Care Resource Center as a vehicle to provide child care resource and referral services to the community. Today, CCRC continues to provide services, funded by a variety of sources, that enhance and enrich our community.

We know the child care industry is a necessary building block for establishing a solid workforce in our local economy. Child Care Resource Center is focused on referring parents (and families) to quality child care programs and partnering with local child care providers to achieve the highest state level standards.
